

NOTES FROM THE HAZZAN

My grandfather once told me that he did not like to say “goodbye,” because it seemed too permanent, too final. Instead, he always departed with “So long!” Perhaps he preferred this because it gives the sense that this is not “goodbye,” only “until we meet again after a long time.”

The rabbis of the Talmud were well aware of the difficulty that we all share when confronting transitions, especially goodbyes. There is a famous joke that while some people leave without saying “goodbye,” Jews say “goodbye” without leaving. Sometimes we humans have difficulty finding closure; it is not easy saying “goodbye.” It is for this reason that the rabbis teach us that one should part his friend not in sadness, not in tears, but with words of Torah.

Implicit in this teaching is the understanding that we may enrich ourselves from all of our human encounters. It is my hope that in our time together over these past twelve years, we have been able to enrich each other in perspective, outlook, and a love of Judaism. It is also my hope that the B’nai Israel community continues to prosper, learn and create a meaningful Jewish life for everyone who comes through its doors.

It has been a pleasure to work closely with such a fine group of individuals during my time here. Thank you to all the synagogue Board members and Executive Committee members from over the years, especially our presidents: Chuck Traugott, Stephen Rothschild, Mark Abramson, Paul Rothschild, Jim Sack, Jim Rothschild, Michael Podolsky and (soon) Meira Zucker. Thank you to our Rabbis: Rabbi Michael Ungar, Rabbi Stanley Schachter, Rabbi Sylvan Kamens, Rabbi Barry Leff and Rabbi Moshe Saks. Thank you to our Religious School directors: Rabbi Wendy Ungar, Denise Greenblatt and Kim Brody. Thank you to our youth advisors: Sheri Knauth, Cathy Skutch, Marna Cousino, Jeremy Szczepanski, Ashley Gaum, Daniel Abramson and Adrienne Goldberg. Thank you to our Office Managers: Carolyn Morey and Kandee Storm. Thank you to George Young for our many years together, and our maintenance person Julie Brunner and our bookkeeper Lou Steingroot, who continue to put up with me. And a special thank you to Rhoda Miller and her Cantorial Search Committee, who brought me here in the first place. All of you have touched my life in a meaningful way, and I shall miss each of you.

There is a saying from Shir HaShirim Rabbah which I know to be true: *“A student receives only a fifth of the reward that is received by the teacher.”* Over the course of the last twelve years, I have taught 126 Bar/Bat Mitzvah students at B’nai Israel. They are, by far, the greatest source of pride during my time here. I not only had the privilege of teaching them, but learning from them as well.

I will not forget the laughs, the tears, the coffee, the jump roping, and my on-the-job education about Harry Potter, Webkinz, Silly Bandz and jeggings, to name a few. Many of you have gone on to lead services, read Torah and chant haftarah after our studies together, and I have beamed with pride every time. I have thoroughly enjoyed watching some of you as you became active in Kadima, USY and BBYO. The students who shared summers with me at Camp Ramah in Canada and in Israel for the Confirmation trip feel like family. It is all of you – my students – who I will miss the most. I leave knowing that the world has many more knowledgeable Jews to carry on our precious traditions. Thank you for enriching my life in such a meaningful way.

Although I will be leaving Ohio, I will not be disappearing off the face of the Earth. I may be on the East Coast, but I’m only an email message away (jamielcloth@gmail.com). Feel free to drop me a note anytime. I would welcome hearing from you.

So for now, I leave you not with “goodbye,” but with “So long!”
